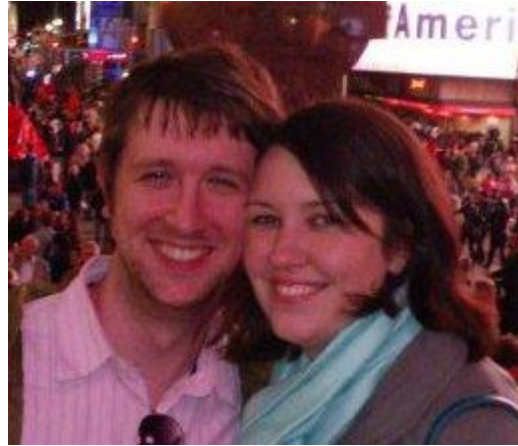


## Narcie Jeter Bio
