For over 32 years, the York County CROPWALK has raised over \$584,000 to help feed the hungry in our neighborhood and around the globe. Hundreds of your neighbors and friends have walked on behalf of those who are struggling with poverty. Twenty five percent of all funds raised stays in York County to help those who are hungry. Over \$146,000 has been distributed locally to Pilgrims' Inn, the Meals on Wheels program at the York County Council on Aging and three emergency food banks: HOPE in Rock Hill, PATH in York, and the Fort Mill CARE Center. These agencies have done and are doing a tremendous job in helping people in our communities. **Checks totaling \$8,026.50 were recently distributed to the above agencies.**

*In 2009, hundreds of our citizens walked in both York and Rock Hill and raised \$32,106 even in the midst of a hurting economy.*
